REPORT OF FOREST AND WINDBARRIER PLANTING
IN THE UNITED STATES

(July 1, 1957 - June 30, 1958)

Acres planted--fiscal year 1958 and previous years

Tree planting during the fiscal year 1958 (July 1, 1957 to June 30, 1958) as reported by various public agencies, principally the State Foresters, was as follows:

This is a new record--higher by nearly 400,000 acres than the previous record set in 1957. The rate of planting has doubled in 5 years, and has tripled in 9 years.

**This is the area reported by the State Foresters and others as having been planted during the year. It does not represent the area satisfactorily reforested or established to windbarriers, for some of the plantings or seedings are unsuccessful.

There are indications that at least 1-3/4 million acres will be planted in 1959.

The total amount of planting in each State is shown, by class of owners and purpose, in Table 5 of this report. The 12 States in which more than 50,000 acres were planted in 1958 are:

Comparison of the 1958 with the 1957 figures shows changes in planting activity by the three broad ownership classes as follows:

The Federal Government planted 133,509 acres of forest and 4,344 acres of windbarriers in 1958 on lands administered by its various agencies, a total of 137,853 acres. This is 29,401 acres, or 27 percent, more than in 1957.

The States and other non-Federal public agencies planted 74,385 acres of forest and 149 acres of windbarriers, a total of 74,534 acres. This is 9,890 acres, or 15 percent, more than in 1957.

Private landowners planted 1,326,370 acres of forest and 29,951 acres of windbarriers, a total of 1,356,321 acres. This is 358,427 acres, or 33 percent, more than in 1957. A few States reported decreases in tree planting on private land.

In 30 States private forest planting increased by 386,028 acres in the aggregate, over 1957. Some of the State increases were extraordinary--for example:

In 13 States, Puerto Rico, and Hawaii, private forest planting did not change 200 acres either way from what it was in 1957.

In 3 States private forest planting decreased by a total of 28,940 acres. It is unlikely that these decreases are due to recurring situations, and increases next year are probable.

In 3 States no forest planting was reported.

Of all the forest planting, 86 percent is on privately owned lands. States in which private owners planted more than 20,000 acres in 1958 are:

A third of the private forest planting is being done by industrial organizations on their own lands. In 1958 forest industries planted 370,096 acres, 59,460 more than in 1957; and other industries planted 71,822 acres, which is about the same as in 1957. States in which industries planted more than 10,000 acres of industrially owned forest land during 1958 are:

This is 2,885 acres more than was reported in 1957. Nearly all of the increase was on Indian lands in Arizona.

In 1958, the 14 Federally operated nurseries (12 Forest Service and 2 TVA) produced 156,961,000 trees, in comparison with 127,104,000 in 1957. Most of the Forest Service nursery trees were planted in national forests, but some were planted on lands of the Atomic Energy Commission and flood-control projects, and in a few States on private lands through the Federal-State cooperative tree distribution programs. An additional Forest Service nursery to supply seedlings for national forest planting is under construction in California. Nursery stock from the TVA nursery in Tennessee was used on private lands through established programs; stock from the TVA nursery in Alabama was used to plant lands retired under provisions of the Conservation Reserve of the Soil Bank.

The State nurseries produced 1,080,158,000 plants in 1958. The principal producers among the States were:

Seven States did not operate nurseries in 1958. Four of these conduct tree distribution programs by purchasing their supply of stock from commercial nurseries, those of other States, and one Federal nursery.

Forty-two States, plus Puerto Rico and Hawaii operated a total of 101 nurseries in 1958 and produced 1,080,158,000 plants. In 1957, there were 92 State nurseries and their output was 786,288,000 trees. This net increase of 9 nurseries results from closing one very small nursery in Texas, a total of 8 new nurseries in Colorado, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, Nevada, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Texas shipping trees for the first time, and 2 small previously existing nurseries first reported in 1958. Not included in the total of 101 are one idle nursery, 3 producing only wildlife food and cover stock, and 13 under construction. The State Foresters estimate an output of more than 1-1/2 billion trees by State nurseries in 1959.

Most of the stock from these nurseries was produced under either the Federal-State cooperative tree distribution programs (C-M 4) or the Conservation Reserve of the Soil Bank, for planting on privately-owned land.

The demand for additional planting stock created by the Soil Bank Conservation Reserve Program is being met mainly by State nurseries. During fiscal years 1957 to 1959, Soil Bank funds have been provided to expand output capacity of 44 State nurseries and to construct 19 additional State nurseries. The additional capacity is expected to provide approximately 500 million trees in the 1959 planting year and 700 million in 1960.

The stock from the Soil Conservation District nurseries all goes to District cooperators. Thirteen such nurseries are now reported--1 in California, 2 in North Dakota, and 10 in Michigan. Their total output is 10,719,000 trees. This is an increase of 1,850,000 trees over 1957.

The county and municipal nurseries continue as in 1957. Four of these are in operation and their combined output was 422,000 trees, 15,000 more than in 1957. Their output goes to municipal and county lands.

Most seedlings from forest industry and land company nurseries go to plant company lands, although some stock is distributed to private landowners through various company programs. There are now 26 such nurseries, with an output of 187,311,000 plants, as against 22 with an output of 100,713,000 plants in 1957. Two companies closed their nurseries. Six new nurseries shipped their first crop in 1958. Five additional company nurseries are under construction.

Commercial nurseries reported in 1958 numbered 82, and their total output was 119,121,000 plants, including windbarrier planting stock. In 1957 53 such nurseries reported a combined output of 78,080,000 plants. Three of these did not report in 1958 but 32 additional nurseries reported, so there was a net gain of 29 in this class. Eighteen of these newly reporting nurseries are in Michigan; the other 114 are in Colorado, Georgia, Kansas, Minnesota, Montana, New Hampshire, New Jersey, North Dakota, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Washington, and Wisconsin.

Of the 82 commercial nurseries, 28 are in Michigan and 17 in Pennsylvania. Their production runs heavily to Christmas tree planting stock. Twelve commercial nurseries report from Kansas, Nebraska, and the two Dakotas. In the Prairie States, production consists mainly of windbarrier species. The remaining 25 commercial nurseries are scattered among 15 States from coast to coast.

Direct seeding

The reported acreage of direct sowing of tree seeds is increasing each year. The amount of such work is detailed in footnotes to Tables 1, 2, and 3 of this report, and is summarized below:

Direct sowing of tree seeds from the air and the ground has increased in recent years and is expected to increase much more due to the development and use of compounds effective in reducing or eliminating the eating of the seeds by rodents and birds. Seeds are coated with an endrin-arasan formulation to repel rodents where this is a problem and with anthraquinone to repel birds. This latter compound has also been found effective in protecting seeds sown in nurseries from depredation by birds.

There are other hazards to successful reforestation through direct seeding, such as frost, growth, and insects which will limit the use of this method of reforestation. Research and field trials are underway to determine site preparation requirements and to find chemicals to reduce the effects of these hazards. However, the success of seedings in many areas using presently recommended techniques is encouraging expansion of this method. The big advantage is in the ability to cover large areas in one season and **if** a stand is established with one or even two seedings, the cost per acre can be much less than by planting nursery stock.
