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REPORT OF FOREST AND WINDBARRIER PLANTING AND SEEDING IN THE UNITED STATES

(July 1, 1960 - June 30, 1961)

Acres Planted - FY 1961 and Previous Years

Tree planting during the fiscal year 1961 (July 1, 1960 - June 30, 1961) as reported by various public agencies, principally the State foresters, was as follows:

The 341,254 acre reduction in tree planting from last year's figure of 2,137,460 acres is due primarily to the substantial reduction in planting on land withdrawn from agricultural production through Conservation Reserve Soil Bank contracts. The 1,796,206 acres planted in 1961 includes a substantial acreage of Soil Bank planting or replanting. However, the Soil Bank influence is much less in 1961 than in the total acreages reported as planted in 1959 and 1960.

**This does not represent the area satisfactorily reforested or established to windbarriers, for some of the plantings or seedings are unsuccessful. Comparison of the 1961 with the 1960 figures shows changes in planting activity by the three broad ownership classes as follows:

The <u>Federal Government</u> planted 204,002 acres of forest and 700 acres of windbarriers in 1961 on lands administered by its various agencies; a total of 204,702 acres. This is 30,209 acres or 17.3 percent more than in 1960. (Federal windbarrier planting decreased 307 acres.)

The <u>States and other non-Federal public agencies</u> planted 102,135 acres of forest and 121 acres of windbarriers; a total of 102,256 acres. This is 10,925 acres or 12 percent more than in 1960. (Windbarrier plantings on State lands increased 6 acres.)

<u>Private landowners</u> planted 1,455,898 acres of forest and 33,350 acres of windbarriers; a total of 1,489,158 acres. This is 382,388 acres or 20.4 percent less than in 1960. (Private windbarrier plantings decreased 894 acres.) A further analysis of the preceding figures shows that forest planting on forest industry and other industry land increased substantially, whereas forest planting on privately-owned land in smaller holdings decreased a total of 432,730 acres, or 35.4 percent.

Eighty-three percent of all forest planting is on privately-owned lands. The 17 States with forest plantings of over 20,000 acres on privatelyowned land are listed below. This listing also includes the 13 States with more than 10,000 acres of planting on industry-owned land. It should be noted that more than 50 percent of private land forest planting in 5 of these 17 States is on industry-owned land. These States are Washington with 93.4%, Oregon with 85.6%, Louisiana with 73.9%, Texas with 70.0%, and Florida with 68.4%.

Nearly 46 percent of the private forest planting in. 1961 was on land owned by industrial organizations compared to 33.6 percent in 1960. In 1961 forest industries planted 589,163 acres, 147,765 acres more than in 1960; and other industries planted 78,752 acres, 17,777 acres less than in 1960.

Windbarrier Planting

Windbarrier planting was reported from 31 States and Puerto Rico. It amounted to 34,171 acres, classed as follows:

Private land windbarrier planting decreased 894 acres in 1961. The public agencies planted 307 acres less than in 1960. The overall result is a decrease of 2.5 percent from the previous year.

In 1961 the 15 Federal nurseries shipped 130,104,000 trees in comparison with 177,698,000 in 1960. Most of the Forest Service nursery trees were planted on National Forest lands. Nursery stock from the Tennessee Valley Authority nurseries was used on private lands through established programs. The closing of one TVA nursery and the reduction of more than 32 million in the number of trees shipped was due to the large reduction in the need for trees for Soil Bank plantings.

The <u>State nurseries</u> shipped 1,001,103,000 plants in 1961. Most of the stock from these nurseries was produced under the Federal-State cooperative tree distribution program (C-M 4) or the Conservation Reserve of the Soil Bank for planting on private lands. The 10 States with the largest shipments were:

These 10 States shipped 49 percent of the Nation's entire supply.

Forty-three States and Puerto Rico shipped 1,001,103,000 trees from 103 nurseries in 1961. In 1960, 108 nurseries shipped 1,359,306,000 plants.

Forty-eight States and Puerto Rico conducted tree distribution programs in 1961. Five of these purchased all of the trees they distributed from commercial, other State, or Federal nurseries. Arizona and Alaska are the only two States that did not distribute trees in 1961.

The total output of the 11 <u>Soil Conservation District nurseries</u> was 13,074,000 trees as against 13,262,000 for the 11 nurseries in 1960. The stock from these nurseries all goes to District cooperators for planting on private lands.

There are now 3 <u>county and municipal nurseries</u>. They produced 479,000 trees in 1961 as against 558,000 from four nurseries in 1960. Their entire output is planted on public lands.

Most seedlings from <u>forest industry and land company nurseries</u> go to plant company lands, although some stock is distributed to other private landowners through various company programs. There were 35 such nurseries in 1961 with an output of 295,755,000 trees as against an output of 258,810,000 trees in 1960.

<u>Commercial nurseries</u> reporting in 1961 numbered 89 and their total output was 97,043,000 plants, which is 11 percent less than in 1960. No commercial production of forest or windbarrier planting stock is reported from 28 States and Puerto Rico.

Of the 89 commercial nurseries that reported, 24 are in Pennsylvania and 26 are in Michigan. Their production runs heavily to Christmas tree planting stock. Twelve commercial nurseries reported from Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Nebraska, and the two Dakotas. They produce mainly windbarrier species in addition to much ornamental stock not reported herein. A large share of their production is sold to the States for distribution under the Federal-State cooperative tree planting program. The other 27 commercial nurseries are located in 14 States distributed from coast to coast, primarily in the North.

Direct Seeding

The reported acreage of direct sowing of tree seeds increased substantially in 1961. Thirty-three States reported from 1 to 67,924 acres. The amount of such work is detailed in Table 4 of this report and is summarized below:
