

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON IMPROVEMENT OF OTHER SPECIES

As some of you may remember there was formed, in the waning moments of last year's NEFTIC, a Committee on the Improvement of "Other" Species -- those which were not covered by existing committees. The purpose of this Committee was to investigate the possibilities of and interest in the improvement of other species. We have two recommendations:

1. We recommend the establishment of a Committee on the Improvement of Larch with David B. Cook as Chairman and Clyde Chandler as a member.

2. We also recommend that a Committee on the Improvement of Virginia Pine be set up with Albert G. Snow, Jr., as Chairman. The members mentioned have agreed to serve.

The Conference accepted the recommendations of the Committee on the Improvement of Other Species and voted to establish the following new technical Committees, with instructions to the chairmen to select any additional committee members:
