The site grows about 14 million conifer seedlings a year for internal and external reforestation customers. Western Regeneration is comprised of 4 nurseries and 4 seed orchards throughout Western Washington and Oregon.

Key Functions:

- Role model safety, professionalism, integrity, and positive work attitude.
- Team member will flow to the different departments (Seed Orchard, Greenhouse Operations and Bare Root Nursery) of the site to work with those groups at times of peak production.
- Be a safety leader and participate in safety documentation, record keeping, job hazard analyses, reliable procedures, and required safety training.
- Diagnosis and troubleshooting of irrigation equipment issues and perform preventive maintenance on the irrigation equipment.
